1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. On the prayer of the learned counsel for the Petitioners, he is permitted to add the Informant as Opposite Party No.2 in this CRLMC application.
 3. Let a corrected copy of the cause title of the CRLMC application be uploaded/filed within three working days hence.
 4. Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioners as well as the learned counsel for the State. Perused the application as well as the prayer made therein.
 5. On a careful scrutiny of the allegation made in the F.I.R., it appears that the present dispute arises out of a matrimonial discord between the husband and the Opposite Party No.2-wife.



6. In view of the aforesaid position, this Court is of the view that an attempt can very well be made to resolve the dispute amicable through mechanism of mediation.
7. Hence, issue notice to the newly added Opposite Party No.2 by Speed Post with A.D. by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites for issuance of notice be filed within three working days hence.
8. List this matter in the week commencing 27th January, 2026.
9. As an interim measure, it is directed that on an application being filed by the Petitioners before the court in seisin over the matter seeking adjournment of the case, the court in seisin over the matter shall do well to adjourn the case for a period of four weeks.
