- 07.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard.
3. Even though this I.A. has been filed with a prayer to direct O.P. No.3 to release the salary of the petitioner from the month of October, 2024, but on instruction learned Addl. Standing Counsel contended that after passing of the interim order by this Court on 22.10.2024, petitioner performed the duty only on 28.10.2024 and 29.10.2024. But w.e.f. 30.10.2024 to till date petitioner is continuing on leave by making separate leave applications. Instruction so provided by O.P. No.3 be kept in record.
4. To the stand taken in the instruction, learned counsel for the petitioner contended that even though in terms of the interim order



passed on 22.10.2024, petitioner was allowed to discharge her duty w.e.f. 28.10.2024, but because of the intervention of the local villagers, petitioner was not allowed to discharge her duty w.e.f. 30.10.2024 and on compelling circumstances submitted the leave applications.

4.1. However, learned counsel for the petitioner contended that now O.P. No.3 has passed a fresh order on 30.12.2024 by allowing the petitioner to continue in her present place of posting subject to outcome of the present Writ Petition. Copy of office order dated 30.12.2024 so produced in Court be kept in record.

5. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the submissions made, this Court while disposing the I.A., permits the petitioner to join in terms of the office order dated 30.12.2024. The break period till the date of joining be regularized by O.P. No.3 in accordance with law.

6. I.A. stands disposed of.
