01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners as well as learned counsel for the State.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioners at the outset contended that the present dispute arises out of a matrimonial dispute. He further contended that the present case has been registered at the instance of the wife-Opposite Party No.2 against husband-Petitioner No.1 and his parents who are Petitioner Nos.2 and 3. He further contended that there exists a good chance of matter being amicably settled.
4. Taking into consideration the aforesaid submission, this Court is inclined to issue notice to the Opposite Parties for the aforesaid limited purpose.



5. Since Mr. Jena, learned Additional Standing Counsel for State-Opposite Party accepts notice on behalf of Opposite Party No.1, let an extra copy of the brief be served on him within three working days.

6. Issue notice to the Opposite Party No.2 by Speed Post with A.D. fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within three working days.

7. List this matter in the week commencing 08.12.2025.
