01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
2. By means of this application, the Petitioner seeks the intervention of this Court for a direction to Opposite Party Nos.2 and 3 to register the complaint and proceed with the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that, for redressal of the Petitioner's grievance, he approached the IIC, Salepur Police Station by filing a complaint dated 26.07.2025. As no action was taken thereon, the matter was brought to the notice of the Superintendent of Police, Cuttack on 31.08.2025, but to no avail.

Having regard to the aforesaid submission of learned counsel for the Petitioner and the allegations made in the complaint, Opposite Party No.3, the Inspector-in-Charge, Salepur P.S., is directed to examine the complaint and, in the event, it discloses a cognizable offence, to act in accordance with law.
