1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. The present Writ Petition has been filed by the Petitioner with the following prayer:

“That from the above-mentioned circumstances and materials placed on record the Petitioner humbly prays before this Hon'ble Court to direct the following:

- i. Admit the instant writ petition;
- ii. Issue notice upon the Opposite Parties;
- iii. Call for records of UAP Case No. 22 of 2021 adjudicated by the Opposite Party No.3 i.e. The Deputy Commissioner (ODA Act), Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation, Bhubaneswar & Appeal Case No. 07 of 2023 adjudicated by the Opposite Party No.1 i.e. State of Odisha, being represented through its Principal Secretary to Government in Housing & Urban Development Department;
- iv. And after hearing parties from both sides may be pleased to set aside/quash the impugned order dated 22.02.2023 passed in UAP Case No. 22 of 2021 and order dated 21.06.2025 passed in Appeal Case No. 07 of 2023;

And this Hon'ble Court may further be pleased to pass any other order/orders for proper adjudication in of instant matter;”

4. Issue notice to the Opposite Parties.
5. Learned counsel for the State waive of notice on behalf of the Opposite Party No.1. An extra copy of the Writ Petition be served on him in order to enable him to take instruction in the matter.
6. Learned counsel for the Petitioner is further directed to serve a copy of the Writ Petition on Mr. Iswar Mohanty, learned counsel who usually appears on behalf of the Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation in order to enable him to take instruction in the matter.
