1. This application has been filed with a prayer to quash the order of cognizance dated 31.12.2024 in G.R. Case No. 1986 of 2024 in the Court of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Berhampur, Ganjam which arises out of Berhampur Mahila P.S. Case No. 172 of 2024.

2. Mr. Baral, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that Opposite Party No. 2 is the wife of Petitioner No.1 and cognizance of offences under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code (in short, the 'IPC') and other sections had been taken vide order dated 31.12.2024 but in the meantime due to intervention of village gentry, the matter has been settled between the parties and C.P. No. 120 of 2025 had been filed by the Petitioner No. 1 and Opposite Party No.2



under section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act and although the judgment has been passed on 29.10.2025 (after filing of this application) certified copy of the judgment and decree could not be obtained as decree has not yet been prepared). He further submits if a short adjournment is granted, Opposite Party No.2 will appear in the case and he shall also file the copy of the judgment in C.P. No. 120 of 2025.

3. Considering the said submissions, list this matter in the week commencing from 01.12.2025.

4. In the meanwhile, Mr. Biswal, learned Additional Standing Counsel shall obtain instructions regarding settlement of the matter between the Petitioners and the Opposite Party No.2.
