1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is a bail application U/S.483 of BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Chhendipada PS Case No.445 of 2025 corresponding to GR Case No.1133 of 2025 pending in the file of learned JMFC, Chhendipada for commission of offences punishable U/Ss. 64(2)(k)/64(2)(m)/351(3) of BNS read, on the main allegation of committing rape upon a deaf and dumb lady.
3. In the course of hearing, Mr.Amit Kumar Nath, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is aged about 65 years, whereas the victim is aged about 40 years and the case arises out of a love relationship between them and, therefore, the petitioner may kindly be granted bail.



3.1. On the other hand, Mr.C.Mohanty, learned Addl. PP by placing the statement of the victim prays to reject the bail application of the petitioner.

4. After having considered the rival submissions upon perusal of record, there appears allegation against the petitioner for committing upon a physically challenged lady, but the plea as advanced for the petitioner merits no consideration at this stage, since the evidence is yet to be led nor any material is there to that effect. In that view of the matter and taking into account the nature and gravity of the offences as alleged against the petitioner vis-à-vis the materials placed on record, more particularly statement of the victim, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

5. Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stands rejected. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of.
