- 02.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No.921 of 2025 pending on the file of learned J.M.F.C-V, Bhubaneswar, arising out of Airport P.S. Case No.168 of 2025 for commission of offences punishable under Sections 318(4) of BNS, 2023.
3. Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that inadvertently requisites could not be filed on time, learned counsel for the Petitioner is requested to serve an extra copy of the brief on the learned counsel for the State by 16.12.2025, who is requested to serve the notice on the informant through the I.O. indicating that the matter shall be taken up on 28.01.2026.



4. List this matter on 28.01.2026. Learned counsel for the State is called upon to obtain the Case Diary in the meanwhile.

5. As an interim measure, it is directed that the Petitioner shall not be taken into custody in connection with the aforesaid case, till the next date.

In the event steps for issuance of notice are not taken, as directed, the interim order shall stand vacated.

6. It is needless to say that the Petitioner shall cooperate with the Investigating Agency.
