- 1.** Learned counsel for the petitioner was heard at some length.
- 2.** The petitioner-husband in the marriage is before this Court challenging the judgment dated 19.09.2025 passed by the learned Judge, Family Court, Rayagada, in CR.P. No. 05 of 2025.
- 3.** The said CR.P. was initiated at the instance of the Opp. Party-wife in the marriage and two children under section 144 of BNSS, 2023 seeking monthly maintenance of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand only) per month each stating in the application that on 14.05.2002, the Opp. Party-wife and the present petitioner-husband got married, from their wedlock one son is aged about twenty years and one daughter aged about nineteen years have been born.



5. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner herein that the petitioner disputes the marriage.

6. By the judgment dated 19.09.2025, the learned Judge, Family Court, Rayagada has allowed the petition partly directing payment of Rs.7,000/- (rupees seven thousand only) per month to the petitioner-wife as maintenance.

To arrive at the conclusion, the learned Court has examined one witness on behalf of the petitioner-wife, two witnesses on behalf of the Opp. Party-husband, five exhibits exhibited by the petitioner-wife and four exhibits exhibited by the Opp. Party-husband.

7. On being asked whether the petitioner in any manner has complied with the judgment and decree which is in the form of a money decree as directed by the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Rajnish v. Neha: AIR 2021 SC 569: (2021) 2 SCC 324.**

8. In response, it is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner will deposit of Rs.42,000/- (rupees forty two thousand only) before the learned Judge, Family Court, Rayagada which can be received by the Opp. Party-wife pursuant to the direction of the learned Judge, Family Court, Rayagada in CR.P. No.05 of 2025. It is further submitted that the said amount shall be deposited within four weeks.



9. Accordingly, as prayed, four weeks' time granted for deposit of Rs.42,000/- (rupees forty two thousand only) before the learned Judge, Family Court, Rayagada and proof of deposit shall be filed before this Court to be kept on record of the present petition.

10. Issue notice along with this order.

Issuance of notice is made subject to payment and deposit of Rs.42,000/- (rupees forty two thousand only) as directed above.

Requisites for issuance of notice by Speed Post with registration and proof of delivery shall be filed within seven working days. Returnable date be fixed to 11.03.2026.
