02. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. In filing this Writ Petition, the Petitioner being a loanee, has sought for a direction from this Court to the Manager, Suryoday Small Finance Bank, Panposh Chowk Branch/Opposite Party No.2 for not seizing his vehicle in question.
- Apart from the above, the Petitioner has also sought for a direction from this Court to the Opposite Party No.2 for permitting him to clear the entire loan outstanding dues in six months.
3. Heard.
4. Looking to the prayer made in this Writ Petition, this Court is of the view that this Writ Petition is not



maintainable against the private Finance Company. However, in order to resolve the dispute in a spirit of mediation, this Court directs the Petitioner to approach the Manager, Suryoday Small Finance Bank, Panposh Chowk Branch/ Opposite Party No.2 along with a decent proposal for settlement of the loan outstanding dues, within a period of fifteen working days hence. In such event, the said authority shall look into the grievance of the Petitioner and take a lawful decision in the matter in the spirit of mediation within a period of ten working days thereafter.

5. This Writ Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
