- 02.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.527 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C. (COG), Kendrapara, arising out of Nikirai P.S. Case No.369 of 2025 for commission of offence punishable under Section 109/82(1)/85/3(5) of BNS.
3. At the outset, learned counsel for the State, on instruction, submits that Petitioner Nos.4 and 5 (Bhagyashree Patra and Chandrabhanu Das) have not been cited as accused in the filing of the final form.



Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of in respect of the Petitioner Nos.4 and 5 (Bhagyashree Patra and Chandrabhanu Das).

4. It is also brought to the notice of this Court that, on instructions, the charge sheet has not been filed, inter alia, under Section 109 of BNS.

5. Considering the same, so far as the Petitioner Nos. 1 to 3 (Satyabhama Das, Kalpana Patra and Puspallata Patra) are concerned, they are ladies, it is directed that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the Petitioner Nos. 1 to 3 (Satyabhama Das, Kalpana Patra and Puspallata Patra) shall be released on bail by the learned Court in seisin on such terms as deemed just and proper.

6. It is needless to state that the Petitioner Nos. 1 to 3 (Satyabhama Das, Kalpana Patra and Puspallata Patra) shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.

7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of. U.C.C. as per rules.
