- 02.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.986 of 2025 pending on the file of learned J.M.F.C.(IV), Cuttack, arising out of 42 Mouza P.S. Case No.282 of 2025 for commission of offences punishable under Section 109(1)/ 117(2)/ 126(2)/ 190/ 191(2)/ 191(3)/ 303(2)/ 324(2) of the BNS, 2023.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that though the injury has been categorized as simple, considering the same corresponding to allegations, no leniency ought to be shown.



4. Learned counsel for the State opposes such prayer.

5. Taking into account the nature of allegations, it is directed that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the Petitioner shall be released on bail by the learned Court in seisin on such terms as deemed just and proper.

6. Additionally, it is directed that Petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional police station once every three month on such date and time to be fixed by the learned Court in seisin till the submission of final form. Certification of such appearance shall be submitted to the Court in seisin.

7. It is needless to state that the Petitioner shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.

8. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of. U.C.C. as per rules.
