- 02.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R Case No.338 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Bhadrak, arising out of Puruna Bazar P.S. Case No.250 of 2025 for commission of offence punishable under Sections 109(1)/115(2)/118(1)/118(2)/126(2)/296/3(5)/303(2)/351(2)/74/76 of BNS.



3. It is submitted by the learned counsel that since the exaggerated allegations have been made against the Petitioners, they may be protected by pre-arrest bail.
4. Learned counsel for the State submits that though the injuries have been categorized as simple but the same are corresponding to the allegations. Hence, they may not be protected by pre-arrest bail.
5. Taking into account the rival submissions, it is directed that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the Petitioners shall be released on bail by the learned Court in seisin on such terms as deemed just and proper.
6. It is needless to state that the Petitioners shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.
7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of.
