1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Since the appellant has already filed the cheque of Rs.25,000/- towards the statutory deposit, the cheque amount be invested in the name of Registrar (Judicial) in any Nationalized Bank by opening an interest bearing account renewable from time to time. Accordingly, the IA No.2466 of 2025 stands disposed of.
3. The appellant-petitioner has filed IA No.2818 of 2025 under Rule-22(2) of the Orissa Motor Vehicles (Accident Claims Tribunal) Rules, 1960 (in short, "the Rules") for exemption from paying of Court fees for time being.
4. Heard, learned counsel for the appellant and perused the record.



5. After hearing learned counsel for the appellant and on going through the averments of the IA, the prayer of the appellant for exemption of payment of Court fees for the time being stands allowed till disposal of this appeal. It is, however, made clear that the appellant shall be liable to pay the Court fees as exempted by this order at the time of receiving the award. Accordingly, the IA No.2818 of 2025 stands disposed of.

6. Heard. Issue notice on admission to the Respondent by Speed Post with AD fixing a short returnable date. Requisites for issuance of notice shall be filed within three working days.
