This application has been filed praying for a direction to the learned Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Narasinghpur to dispose of CMA No.05 of 2023 filed by the plaintiff-petitioner which arises out of I.A. No.07 of 2013 (arising out of C.S. No.27 of 2012). The I.A. has been filed with a prayer to pass an order of ad interim injunction for restraining the opposite parties and their agents from coming over the suit land on the grounds stated therein.

2. Mr. Bidyadhar Muduli, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that I.A. No.07 of 2013 filed under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 of CPC had been allowed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Narasinghpur directing both the parties to maintain status quo till disposal of the Original



Suit vide order dated 20.09.2013. He further submits that after passing of the order of status quo, the suit had been dismissed for default and thereafter it has been restored but inadvertently this has not been stated in the CMP.

3. He further submits that the order dated 20.09.2013 has been challenged in FAO No.02 of 2014 before the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Athagarh but the same was not entertained. It appears that the FAO was not entertained as the Civil Suit had been dismissed for default in the meanwhile.

4. In view of the innocuous nature of order, I propose to pass, I do not consider it necessary to direct the learned counsel for the petitioner to amend the CMA or to issue notice to the opposite parties.

5. This CMP is accordingly disposed of requesting the learned Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Narasinghpur to dispose of CMA No. 05 of 2023 within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order but after hearing the other side and if there is no other legal impediment. It is made clear that I have not gone into the merits of the CMA No. 05 of 2023.

Urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
