Heard learned counsel for the Appellant.

Seen the reporting of the Registry. It has been reported therein that the cheque submitted by the Appellant as statutory deposit becomes invalid in the meantime. Invalid cheque be returned to the Appellant through its counsel, who is directed to get the cheque revalidated and deposit the same before the Registry of this Court within a period of ten working days thereafter and the deposit made by the Appellant through the said cheque shall be invested in any Nationalized Bank at higher rate of interest on long term basis. Failure of which the appeal shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Bench.

Registry is directed to see that the matter concerning utilization of cheques so deposited shall be placed before the assigned Bench before the cheque becomes invalid and also see no further invalidated cheque can be submitted by the learned Counsel.

As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19 situation are continuing, learned counsel for the parties may utilize a printout of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587, dated 25th March, 2020 as modified by Court's Notice No.4798, dated 15th April, 2021.
