Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. He draws attention of the Court to the so-called policy decision of the Government, which permits MLAs & MPs to recommend fifteen deserving cases of transfer of teachers and in pursuance thereof, the transfer of the petitioner has been affected. He argues that there is no authority nor justification for the so-called policy decision, as reflected in the letter dated 13.05.2025 of the Joint Secretary to Government circulated amongst the Director of Secondary Education and Director of Elementary Education, Odisha, Bhubaneswar. He also tells that pursuant to this letter, the transfer of his client has been affected and the same is unjustifiable.



2. A case is made out for issuance of notice and grant of interim relief as well.

Issue emergent notice. learned AGA, Mr. Jee, on request of the Court, accepts notice for the O.Ps.

Interim order of stay of subject transfer, so far as the petitioner is concerned, till the next date of hearing.

Call this matter after four weeks along with W.P.(C) No.20894 of 2025.
