1. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
 2. By means of this application, the Petitioner seeks the intervention of this Court for a direction to Opposite Party No.2, the Superintendent of Police, Dhenkanal, to ensure a proper investigation and/or to hand over the investigation to an independent investigating agency in connection with Kamakhya Nagar P.S. Case No.325 of 2025 and P.S. Case No.359 of 2025.
 3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that, despite the gravity of the allegations, although the matter has already been registered vide Kamakhya Nagar P.S.



Case No.325 of 2025 dated 25.06.2025, no proper investigation has been carried out so far. Mr. Tripathy, learned counsel for the Petitioner, also drew the attention of this Court to the nature and seriousness of the offences under which FIR No.359 of 2025 has been registered.

4. Having regard to the aforesaid submissions of Mr. Tripathy, learned counsel for the Petitioner, the allegations made in the complaints, and the nature of the offences alleged in the FIRs, it is expected that the Investigating Agency would proceed with the investigation fairly, diligently, and with promptitude. Accordingly, Opposite Party No.3, the Inspector-in-Charge, Kamakhya Nagar P.S., is directed to monitor and ensure a fair and diligent investigation and to take steps for early conclusion thereof by submission of the Final Form, if any, within a period of one month, if there be no other legal impediment. The CRLMP accordingly stands disposed of.
