2. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. This writ petition has been filed for the following relief:

*“It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble court may graciously be pleased to allow this writ petition and pass appropriated order and,*

- a. *Issue a Writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ Order, or Direction, directing the Opp. Party No.2, Tahasildar, Sambalpur to forthwith comply with the Order of Remand passed by the Hon'ble Board of Revenue in OEA Revision Case No.158 of 2000 dated 20.03.2004, as upheld by this Hon'ble Court in W.P.(C) No. 10585 of 2004 (and W.P. (C) No. 2082 of 2005).*
- b. *Direct the Opp. Party No.2 to conclude the remanded fresh inquiry/adjudication proceedings within a stipulated time frame to ensure finality to the rights of*



*the parties, thereby allowing the rightful party to utilize the agricultural land for cultivation and trust.*

- c. *Pass any other order/orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice.*

*And for this act of kindness, the Petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray."*

3. Mr. Mishra, learned counsel for the Petitioner by filing a memo prays for withdrawal of the writ petition. Memo so filed is taken on record.
