The short grievance of the petitioner is as to non-payment of arrears due, which he says that the same has been withheld during the period between 30.11.2015 and 18.12.2015.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has made a representation dated 02.09.2024 at Annexure-3 and if a direction is given to consider the same, justice would be accorded to his client. With the above proposal, learned ASC appearing for the official OPs is agreeable. He caveats that a reasonable period should be granted and all contentions should be kept open for consideration of the subject representation.

In the above circumstances, time for consideration of subject representation at Annexure-3 and to inform result of such consideration to the petitioner, is eight weeks. All contentions are kept open. He adds



that the subject representation be considered in the light of decision of Apex Court in ***Union of India v. Tarsem Singh, 2008 (8) SCC 648.***

It is open to the answering OPs to solicit any information or document from side of the petitioner, as are required for due consideration of the subject representation; however, in that guise delay shall not be brooked.

Now, no costs.
