This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Learned Counsel for the Opposite Party submits, there is every possibility of resolving the dispute and difference between the parties amicably through mediation.

3. Accordingly, he prays for a direction to the parties to appear before the learned Mediator, High Court Mediation Centre, Aain Seva Bhawan, Cuttack for mediation.

4. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits, he has no objection to such prayer made by the learned Counsel for the Opposite Party.

5. Accordingly, the matter is referred to the High Court Mediation Centre for mediation.

6. As suggested by the learned Counsel for the parties, both the parties are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 09.01.2026, at 3.00 P.M., at the High Court Mediation Centre, Aain Seva Bhawan, Cuttack unfailingly along with their Counsels and make an endeavour to settle



the matter amicably.

7. The matter be listed in the week commencing from 9th February, 2026 awaiting mediation report.

9. Learned Counsel for the parties are requested to ensure presence of the parties before the learned Mediator on the date and time, as detailed above.

10. It is made clear that on the date fixed for mediation, only the Counsels, who represent the parties before this Court in the present writ petition, shall be permitted to remain present along with the parties during mediation. Learned Mediator is directed to ensure the same.

11. In view of the interim arrangement made vide order dated 11.11.2025, the Petitioner is granted further liberty to move for an adjournment in C.P. No.726 of 2024 before the learned Court below, if so required in the meantime.
