02. 1. By means of this application, the Petitioner seeks the following relief:-

“It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to

i) Admit the writ application;

ii) Call for LCR

iii) Issue a Rule NISI to the Opp. Parties to file show cause as to why the representation dt.21.07.25 shall not be disposed of and ROR shall not be issued in his favour.

And this Hon'ble Court may issues any writ/writs, order/orders and direction /directions which may deem fit and proper in the ends of Justice.”

2. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this application with a liberty to make a fresh representation before the competent authority. The same is allowed.

3. The Petitioner is at liberty to make the fresh representation before the Opp. Party No.2 i.e. the District Collector, Khurda within a period of 15 days from the date of this order. In the event any such representation is made, the Opp. Party No.2 shall



consider the same in accordance with law within a period of sixty (60) days from the date of submission of such representation.

4. In view of the above submission, the Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
