01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. By means of the present application, the petitioner seeks the intervention of this Court for issuance of a direction to Opposite Party Nos.1 to 4 to investigate the alleged fraudulent activities stated to have been committed by Opposite Party Nos.5 to 7, in connivance with Opposite Party Nos.9 and 10, in connection with initiation of 1CC Case No.32 of 2023, pending before the learned JMFC, Dhamnagar.
3. Learned counsel for the State has placed the written instruction of the IIC, Dhamnagar PS in Court today, the same is taken on record.
4. During the course of hearing, Mr. Dutta, learned counsel for the petitioner, submitted that the claim application arising out of the motor vehicle accident is presently pending consideration



before the learned Additional District Judge-cum-1st MACT, Jajpur, in MACC No.92 of 2023.

5. In view of the aforesaid submission, and considering that the issue relating to the involvement of the vehicle in question and the alleged fraudulent acts are directly in issue before the competent court, namely, the Additional District Judge-cum-1st MACT, Jajpur. Hence, this Court is of the view that unless and until a definite finding is recorded by the said competent court on the said aspects, no direction is warranted at this stage. The cause of action, if any, for the petitioner would accrue only after such findings are rendered by the MACT on appropriate issues.

6. The CRLMC is accordingly disposed of.
