1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. The petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayer:

It is prayed therefore that this Hon'ble Court may be graciously pleased to;

(i) Admit this writ application;

(ii) Call for the records;

(iii) Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other writ/writs, direction/directions directing the opposite parties, more particularly opposite party Nos.2-Collector, Jagatsinghpur for causing an inquiry on the grievance of the petitioner within a stipulated time and direct payment of arrear salary and reinstate the petitioner in service with all service and financial benefits within a reasonable time to be stipulated by this Hon'ble Court;

And further be pleased to pass any other order(s)/writ(s)/direction(s) as this Hon'ble Court deem fit and proper;



And for this act and kindness the petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.

3. In course of hearing, it is pointed out that highlighting such grievance the petitioner has already approached the Collector, Jagatsinghpur by submitting a representation on 11.03.2022. It is stated at the bar that said representation has not yet been disposed of. Since it is for the concerned authority to take a decision at the first instance, the writ application is disposed of directing the Collector, Jagatsinghpur to consider and dispose of the petition within four weeks, if not already disposed of in the meantime.
4. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the claim.
