 3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as the learned counsel for the Opposite Parties No.3 to 6 are present.
 4. Learned counsel for the Opposite Party No.3 to 6 stated before this Court that he has instruction to appear on behalf of the Opposite Party No.1. Therefore, no further notice be sent to Opposite Party No.1. However, notice to Opposite Party No.2 has not been duly served.
