1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is a bail application U/S.483 of the BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Attabira PS Case No. 182 of 2025 corresponding to CT(Spl.) Case No.28 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned Sessions Judge-cum-Judge(Special Court), Bargarh for commission of offences punishable U/Ss. 20(b)(ii)(C) of the NDPS Act, on the main allegation of transporting 120 Kgs and 670 Grams of Contraband Ganja in a Hyundai i20 Car bearing Registration No. CG-04PK-4750.
3. Heard, Mrs. Dipti Rekha Nanda, learned proxy counsel appearing on behalf of Mr. Susanta Kumar Sahu, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. M.R. Patra, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.



4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offences as alleged against the petitioner vis-à-vis the accusations sought to be brought against him and regard being had to the recovery and seizure of 120Kgs and 670 Grams of Contraband Ganja, which is well above the commercial quantity from the Car allegedly in possession of the Petitioner and his consequent failure to satisfy the conditions of Sec. 37 of NDPS Act, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stands rejected. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of. A soft copy of the order be immediately sent to the learned trial Court.
