Order No. 01

1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel appearing for the Opp. Parties.
3. Petitioner has filed the present writ petition inter alia with the following prayer:-

“It is therefore, humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:-

i) Direct the opp. parties to grant pension and pensionary benefits under the Orissa Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1992 by taking in to account his initial date of appointment 10.06.1992 as has been given to similarly situated persons in terms of the order dated 04.01.2023 passed by this Hon'ble court in W.P.(C) No. 32200/2023 and order dated 02.11.2023 passed in W.A. No. 1462/2023 under Annexure-8 & 9 and grant all consequential service and financial benefits:

ii) Pass such other order (s)/direction(s) as would be deem fit and proper in the bonafide interest of Justice;

And for which act of kindness, the petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.”



4. However, taking into account the claim raised in the present Writ Petition, liberty is granted to the Petitioner to make a fresh representation before Opp. Party No. 1 by enclosing all the relevant documents and citations in support of her claim, if any, within a period of three (3) weeks hence.

5. It is observed that if such representation is filed within the aforesaid time period, Opp. Party No. 1 shall do well to take a lawful decision on the same within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of such representation. The order so passed by Opp. Party No. 1 be communicated to the Petitioner.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
