1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is the bail application U/S.483 of the BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Satyabadi PS Case No. 287 of 2025 corresponding to GR Case No.677 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned JMFC-II, Puri for commission of offences punishable U/Ss.85/296/115(2)/351(2)/294/77/3(5) of BNS r/w Sections 66(E)/67/67(A) of the IT Act and Sec. 4 of DP Act, on the main allegation of subjecting his wife to torture and cruelty for demand of dowry, along with co-accused persons in furtherance of their common intention and uploading her photograph in social medial containing of some obscene messages .
3. Heard, Mr. Tara Prasad Mohapatra, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. T.K. Acharya, learned Additional Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.



4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offences as alleged against the petitioner vis-à-vis the accusations sought to be brought against him and regard being had to the pre trial detention of the petitioner in custody since 15.09.2025 with submission of charge sheet in the meantime and taking into account the other circumstances on record in entirety including the inherent right of an accused to be presumed innocent until proven guilty at the trial and keeping in view all the offences being triable by Magistrate with the law laid down by the Apex Court in ***Satender Kumar Antil Vrs. Central Bureau of Investigation; (2022) 10 SCC 51***, this Court without expressing any view on merit admits the petitioner to bail.

5. Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stands allowed and the petitioner is allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin of the case on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by it.

6. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of. Issue urgent certified copy of the order as per Rules.
