01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned counsel for the State-Opposite Parties.

3. The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer:-

“It is therefore, prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to issue rule NISI to the opposite parties and if the opposite parties fail to show cause or shown insufficient cause make the said rule absolute by directing the opposite parties, more particularly the opposite party no.3 to carryout the order of the opposite party no.2 and grant financial upgradation under the RACP/MACP Scheme in favour of the petitioner and further direct the opposite party no.3 to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Senior Assistant within a stipulated period;

And may pass any other appropriate order or orders or direction or directions for the ends of justice.”

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner contended that the request available at Annexure-14 to the Writ



Petition though is pending, but till date nothing has been done in the matter.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs Opposite Party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted request available at Annexure-14 in accordance with law, within a period of 3 (three) months from the date of receipt of this order with due communication to the petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
