1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Since these two bail applications arise out of one and same case record, the same are heard together and disposed of by this common order with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties.
3. These are the bail applications U/S.483 of BNSS by the petitioners for grant of bail in connection with Jeypore Town PS Case No.228 of 2025 corresponding to GR Case No.681 of 2025 pending in the file of learned SDJM, Jeypore, Dist-Koraput, for commission of offences punishable U/Ss.305(a)/331(4) of BNS, on the main allegation of committing theft in the shop of the informant and taking away a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- and some valuables.



4. Heard, Mr. Rohit Mahato, learned counsel for all the petitioners and Mr. M.K. Mohanty, learned Additional Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.

5. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offences as alleged against the petitioners vis-à-vis the accusations sought to be brought against them and regard being had to the pre-trial detention of the petitioners in custody since 22.09.2025 with submission of charge-sheet in the meantime and keeping in view the grant of bail to co-accused S. Dhanjaya @ S. Dhananjay in BLAPL No.9573 of 2025 and taking into account the other circumstances on record in entirety including the inherent right of the accused to be presumed innocent until proven guilty at the trial and the FIR being lodged against unknown persons and further, taking into account the mode and manner of implication of the present petitioners in this case, this Court without expressing any view on merits admits each of the petitioners to bail.

6. Hence, these two bail applications of the petitioners namely Rinku Sarmila @ Samarlia and Surendra Harijan (in BLAPL No.11789 of 2025) and Bhagban Muduli (in BLAPL No.11790 of 2025) are allowed and each of the petitioners is allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin



of the case on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by it.

7. Accordingly, these BLAPLs stand disposed of.
