01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the records.
3. The present Criminal Miscellaneous Case has been filed by the Petitioner with a prayer to quash the entire criminal proceeding initiated against him in C.T. Case No.436 of 2019, arising out of Boudh P.S. Case No.160 of 2019, pending in the court of the learned S.D.J.M., Boudh.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner, at this juncture, submitted that the Petitioner do not want to press this application and seeks permission to withdraw the same with liberty to raise all the points at the time of framing of charge by filing an application of discharge.
5. Considering such submission, this CRLMC stands disposed of as



withdrawn with the liberty as sought for.

6. Further, taking into consideration the submission made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the Petitioner is ready and willing to cooperate with the trial and that some of the co-accused persons have been released on bail in the meantime, it is directed that if the Petitioner surrenders in the aforesaid case in the first hour before the court of the learned S.D.J.M., Boudh within four weeks hence and make a motion for bail, the learned S.D.J.M., Boudh shall consider and dispose of the same strictly on the basis of the materials on record in the first hour. In case of rejection of the bail application, the Petitioner may move for bail before the higher forum in the second hour. On such event, the higher forum shall consider and dispose of the bail application of the Petitioner on the same day strictly on the basis of the materials on record by maintaining the principles of parity, if applicable. .

7. Case Diary be made available to the concerned courts. Records be transmitted to the higher forum at the cost of the Petitioner, if applied for.
