1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Since these two bail applications arise out of one and same case record, the same are heard together and disposed of by this common order with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties.
3. These are the bail applications U/S.483 of BNSS by the petitioners for grant of bail in connection with GR Case No. 1495 of 2025 arising out of Baranga PS Case No. 522 of 2025 pending in the file of learned JMFC-II, Cog. Taking Court, Cuttack being charge sheeted for commission of offences punishable U/Ss. 80(2)/85/3(5)/108/351(2) of BNS r/w Section 4 DP Act, on the main allegation of committing dowry death and abetting commission of the deceased by subjecting her to torture and cruelty for demand of dowry, along



with co-accused persons in furtherance of their common intention.

4. Heard, Mr. Sushanta Kumar Samantaray, learned counsel for the Petitioners and Mr. P. Satpathy, learned Additional Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.

5. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offence as alleged against the petitioners vis-a-vis the accusations sought to be brought against them and regard being had to the pre-trial detention of the petitioners in custody since 22.09.2025 with submission of charge sheet in the meantime and keeping in view the opinion of the Doctor as to cause of death of the deceased in the PM report and taking into account the other circumstances on record in entirety including the inherent right of an accused to be presumed innocent until proven guilty at the trial, this Court without expressing any view on merits admits the petitioners to bail.

6. Hence, these two bail applications of the petitioners namely Bimal Chandra Prusty & Nirmala Pusty @ Prusty in BLAPL Nos. 11817 and 12195 of 2025 are allowed and each of the petitioners is allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two solvent sureties for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin of the case on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by it.



7. Accordingly, these BLAPL Nos. 11817 and 12195 of 2025 stand disposed of. Issue urgent certified copy of the order as per Rules.
