1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).

2. This is a bail application U/S.483 of BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Bangiriposi PS Case No.141 of 2025 corresponding to CT Case No.509 of 2025 pending in the file of learned JMFC-1 Cog Taking Baripada for commission of offences punishable U/Ss.85/296/351(2)/356(2)/3(5) of BNS r/w Sec.4 of DP Act & Sec.67 of IT Act, on the main allegation of subjecting his wife to torture and cruelty and also getting her nude and obscene photographs and videos viral in social media.

3. Heard, Mr. Sukanta Kumar Nayak, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. T.K. Acharya, learned Additional Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.

4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offences as alleged against the petitioner vis-à-vis the



accusations sought to be brought against him and regard being had to the pre trial detention of the petitioner in custody since 01.06.2025 with submission of charge-sheet in the meantime and taking into account the other circumstances on record in entirety including the inherent right of the accused to be presumed innocent until proven guilty at the trial, this Court without expressing any view on merit admits the petitioner to bail.

5. Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stands allowed and the petitioner is allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) only with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin of the case on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by it.

6. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of.
