Mr. Das Nayak, learned counsel for opposite party No.1 submits that the petitioner has been directed to clear the outstanding dues with an intimation by letter dated 19th September, 2025 and while claiming so, he produced a copy of the same. The writ petition is filed seeking renewal of lease of the tenanted premises with such other reliefs sought for. In the meantime, the above demand has been made by the opposite parties with an intimation to the petitioner to clear the dues for a sum of Rs.10,29,283 as on February, 2025 modified later on as Rs.3,31,274/- payable till 30th September, 2020. With the above submission, a short adjournment is requested to file an affidavit.

2. Since the pleadings are complete in all respect allowing the opposite parties to file any such further affidavit,



both sides are directed to be ready for hearing and disposal of the matter on the next date, as in the meantime, the mediation attempted between them by the Court's order dated 30th July, 2025 has become unsuccessful.
