1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is an application U/S.483 of BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Polasara PS Case No. 391 of 2025 corresponding to ST Case No. 128 of 2025 pending in the file of learned Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Kodala, Ganjam for commission of offences punishable U/Ss.21(1)(a)/21(1-B)(a) of the Arms Act, on the main allegation of possessing one single shot pistol without magazine, along with four numbers of country made bullets.
3. Heard, Mr. Partha Sarathi Das, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. P.Satapathy, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.



4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offences as alleged against the petitioner vis-à-vis the accusations sought to be brought against him and regard being had to the pre-trial detention of the petitioner in custody since 02.06.2025 with submission of charge sheet in the meantime and there being no criminal antecedent reported against the petitioner and keeping in view the inherent right of the accused to be presumed innocent until proven guilty at the trial, this Court without expressing any view on merits, admits the petitioner to bail.

5. Hence, the bail application of the Petitioner stands allowed and the Petitioner is allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five Thousand) only with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin of the case on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by it.

6. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of.
