1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).

2. This is a bail application U/S.483 of the BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Naikandihi PS Case No. 242 of 2025 corresponding to GR Case No.1096 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned JMFC, Basudevpur for commission of offences punishable U/Ss.126(2)/ 296(b)/ 109(1)/ 115(2)/ 329(3)/324(2)/74/351(3)/3(5) of BNS, on the main allegation of attempting to the life of the injured Ratan Kumar Ray by assaulting him with lathi and iron rods, along with co-accused resulting in injury to his head and face.

3. Heard, Mr. Satya Narayan Mishra-4, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. M.R. Patra, learned Additional Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.

4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of



the offences as alleged against the petitioner vis-à-vis the accusations sought to be brought against him and regard being had to the pre trial detention of the petitioner in custody since 18.10.2025 with substantial progress in investigation and taking into account the number and nature of injuries sustained by the injured which are opined to be simple in nature and keeping in view the mode and manner of implication of the Petitioner and the circumstance under which the transaction took place, this Court without expressing any view on merit admits the petitioner to bail.

5. Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stands allowed and the petitioner is allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin of the case on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by it with following condition:-

(i) the petitioner shall appear before the IO as and when required for the purpose of investigation till submission of charge sheet.

6. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of. Issue urgent certified copy of the order as per Rules.
