1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard Mr. B. Sahoo, learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner and Mr. S. Das, learned Addl. Standing Counsel appearing for the Opp. Parties.
3. In course of hearing learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner fairly contended that on self-same issue Petitioner has already moved Opp. Party No. 2 in Revision Case No. 29/2025. Since after such filing of the Revision, Opp. Party No. 2 was not available to take up the issue, the present writ petition was filed.
 - 3.1. Learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner also contended that since an interim application has already been filed in Revision Case No. 29/2025, till the interim application is taken up by Opp. Party No. 2, interim order passed by this Court on 17.11.2025 may be allowed to continue.



3.2. It is accordingly contended that Petitioner be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to move Opp. Party No. 2 in Revision Case No. 29/2025.

4. Learned Addl. Standing Counsel has no serious objection to the course of action proposed by the learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner.

5. Having heard learned counsel appearing for the Parties and considering the submission made, this Court while disposing the writ petition, permits the Petitioner to move Revision Case No. 29/2025 pending before Opp. Party No. 2. However, Opp. Party No. 2 is directed to take up the interim application so filed along with the revision case on or before 2nd January, 2026.

6. Till 2nd January, 2026, interim order passed by this Court on 17.11.2025 shall continue.

7. The writ petition accordingly stands disposed of.
