1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. This is an application for condonation of delay of four days in filing the Writ Appeal as pointed out by the S.R.
3. Mr. Ashok Das, learned counsel for the Appellant submits that the Appellant was suffering from viral fever with multiple diseases, for which he could not contact his Advocate and file the Writ Appeal in time. He came to Cuttack on 22.11.2022 and consulted with his Advocate and the Appeal was filed on 23.11.2022. In that process, delay of four days occurred in filing the Writ Appeal.
