1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.

“The petitioners therefore prays that, your Lordships may be pleased to consider the facts stated above, admit the writ application, call for the records and after hearing the parties, the op.parties may kindly be directed to demarcate their land in their presence and then proceed with the wok and not to damage or excavate their land and building situated over Plot No-1125, Khata No-813/196 of Mouza-Bhubaneswar Sahara, Unit No-19, Baramunda, Bhubaneswar under the district of Khurda or else the petitioners will be seriously prejudiced and shall suffer irreparable loss.

Any other order/orders may kindly be passed as this Hon'ble court would deem just and proper.”

7. Learned counsel for the Petitioner is further directed to serve a copy of the Writ Petition on Mr. Iswar Mohanty, learned counsel who usually appears on behalf of the Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation in order to enable him to take instruction in the matter.
8. List this matter on 9th December, 2025.
