1. Mr. Judhithir Sahoo, learned counsel for the Petitioner-Claimant and Mr. Sudeep Kumar Sarangi, learned counsel for the Opposite Parties No.1 and 2 are present.
2. The Petitioner has filed the writ petition challenging the inaction of the Opposite Party-Insurance Company in paying him compensation of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakhs) for his property



damaged due to leakage of LPG cylinder.

3. In full and final settlement of the claim, it is now agreed between the Petitioner-Claimant and the Opposite Parties-Insurance Company that a consolidated amount of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakhs) only, which includes interest, shall be paid by the Insurance Company to the Petitioner-Claimant within a period of eight weeks.

4. The compromise memo signed by Mr. Judhisthir Sahoo, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. Sudeep Kumar Sarangi, learned counsel for the Opposite Parties No.1 and 2 is filed and taken on record.

5. It is, therefore, directed that the Opposite Parties No.1 and 2-Insurance Company shall pay the aforesaid consolidated amount of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakhs) only, which includes interest, within a period of eight weeks from today. It is made clear that no interest is payable on this amount.

6. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
