1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. It is stated by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the



writ appeal preferred by the State-Opposite Parties, bearing W.A. No.165 of 2025 as well as W.A. No.143 of 2025 have already been dismissed vide order dated 07.05.2026 by the Hon'ble Division Bench.

3. In view of the aforesaid development, learned counsel for the Petitioner contended that the order passed by this Court having been affirmed by the Hon'ble Division Bench, has not yet been implemented. As such, it was alleged that the Opposite Parties are guilty of willful and deliberate violation of this Court's order.

4. Learned counsel for the Contemnors-Opposite Parties, on the other hand, sought for some more time to ensure that the order passed by this Court is implemented.

5. Considering the aforesaid factual position, this Court grants the Opposite Parties-Contemnors a further period of four weeks to ensure due compliance with the order passed by this Court, which has been affirmed by the Hon'ble Division Bench in the writ appeals, at the earliest.
