1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Since these two bail applications arise out of one and same case record, the same are heard together and disposed of by this common order with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties.
3. These are applications U/S. 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarika Surakshya Sanhita, 2023 (in short, "BNSS") by the petitioners for grant of bail in connection with Bhadreswar P.S. Case No.41 of 2025 arising out of S.T. Case No.38 of 2025 (G.R. Case No.109 of 2025) pending in the Court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Salipur for commission of offences punishable U/Ss. 331(4)/309(6)/3(5) of BNS, on the main allegation of committing theft from the house of



the informant and taking away jewellery and valuables.

4. Heard, Mr. Smruti Ranjan Rout, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. A. Pradhan, learned Addl. PP in these matters and perused the record.

5. Admittedly, the petitioners are in custody since 18.03.2025, but the FIR has been lodged against unknown persons and in the meantime charge sheet has already been submitted. In such view of the matter and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offences as alleged against the petitioners vis-à-vis the accusations sought to be brought against them and taking into account the other circumstances on record in entirety including the inherent right of an accused to be presumed innocent until proven guilty at the trial and keeping in view grant of bail to co-accused Debasis Sahoo @ Bapi in BLAPL No. 4771 of 2025 by this Court, this Court without expressing any view on merits, admits each of the petitioners to bail.

6. Hence, these two bail applications of each of the petitioners namely Kuna Das (BLAPL No. 12026 of 2025) and Bikash Das (BLAPL No. 12027 of 2025) stand allowed and the petitioners are allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) each with two solvent sureties for the like amount to the satisfaction



of the learned Court in seisin of the case, on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by it with following condition:-

(i) the petitioners shall report attendance before the jurisdictional Police Station once in a fortnight preferably on Sunday of each month in between 10 A.M. to 12 Noon for three (03) months from the actual date of release from the custody.

The IIC of jurisdictional Police Station shall not detain the petitioners unnecessarily after recording their attendance beyond the time as stipulated.

7. Accordingly, these BLAPLs stand disposed of. Issue urgent certified copy of the order as per Rules.
