1. Heard Ms. Mohapatra, learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. Instant writ petition is filed by the petitioner challenging the impugned notice dated 29th October, 2025 at Annexure-1 issued by opposite party No.3 in connection with no confidence motion initiated under Section 24 of the Odisha Grama Panchayats Act, 1964 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act').

3. It is the claim of the petitioner that she did not receive the copies of the resolution and requisition along with impugned notice i.e. Annexure-1, hence, the entire exercise is vitiated.

4. The Court is inclined to consider such a claim with a response of the State, hence, directs Mr. Sahoo, learned ASC



for the State is directed to receive notice and to reply on the next date of hearing.

5. An extra copy of the writ petition with annexures is requested to be served on the State.

6. List on 17th December, 2025 for final hearing and orders, the date on which, the State shall be ready with an affidavit disclosing the details as to the personal service of the notice, whether, accompanied with the proposed resolution and requisition for final orders.
