1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. The appellant-petitioner has filed IA No.2625 of 2025 under Rule-22(2) of the Orissa Motor Vehicles (Accident Claims Tribunal) Rules, 1960 (in short, "the Rules") for exemption from paying of Court fees for time being.
3. Heard, Mr. Sriram Krushna Jajodia, learned counsel for the appellant and perused the record including the copy of the affidavit stated to be sworn in by the appellant herself.
4. After hearing learned counsel for the appellant and on going through the averments of the IA and taking into account the additional affidavit of the appellant in which she has undertaken to pay the Court fee after final disposal of the appeal, the prayer of the appellants for exemption of payment of Court fees for the time being stands allowed till disposal of this



appeal. It is, however, made clear that the appellant shall be liable to pay the Court fees as exempted by this order after disposal of the appeal.

5. Accordingly, the IA No.2625 of 2025 stands disposed of.

6. The appellant-petitioner has filed IA No.2626 of 2025 U/S.5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay of 02 days in preferring the appeal.

7. Heard. Issue notice on the question of admission and limitation against Respondents by Speed Post with AD fixing a short returnable date. Requisites for issuance of notice to the Respondents shall be filed within three working days. List this matter on 06.03.2026.
