1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
 3. It is stated by the learned counsel appearing for Opposite Party-Contemnor that order dated 10.04.2025 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) No.31976 of 2024 has already been implemented in the meantime.
 4. Learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner on the other hand raise serious objection with regard to the compliance of order dated 10.04.2025. He further contended that only a part of the order has been implemented.



5. Learned counsel for the Opposite Party-Contemnor produced a copy of letter dated 30.03.2026 of the Additional Treasury Officer, Special Treasury, Cuttack in support of his contention that the pension and retirement amount has already been disbursed in favour of the Petitioner.

6. In view of such development, the contempt proceeding is dropped with liberty to the Petitioner to approach this Court again by filing a fresh writ application in the event, the cause of action still survives and it is found that the Petitioner has not been paid the retirement dues as is due and admissible to him.
