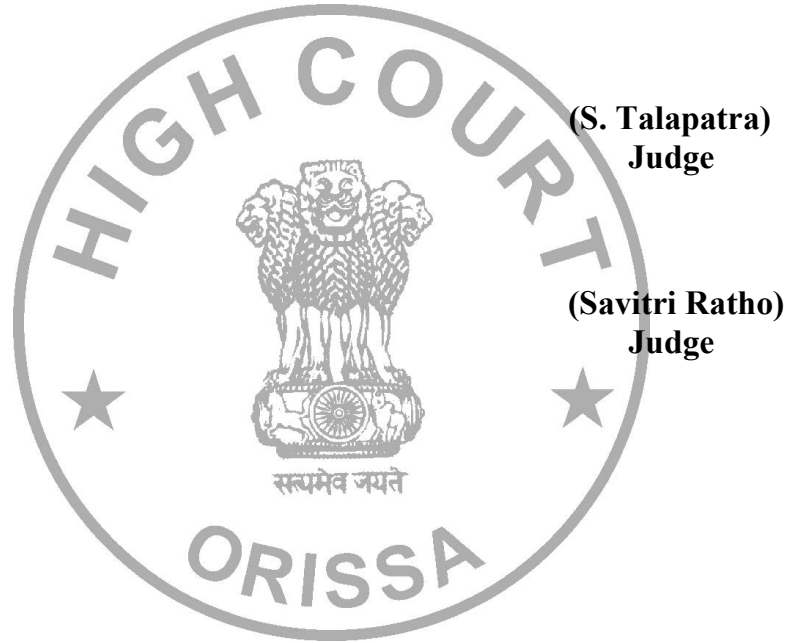

1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard Mr. G. Mukherji, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Mr. Pronoy Mohanty, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and Mr. D. Nayak, learned Additional Government Advocate appearing for the opposite parties.
3. In the course of submission, Mr. Mukherji, learned Senior Counsel has pointed out from the order dated 18.10.2021 of the Chief Secretary, available at page 182 and 184 in the writ petition that after discussion held between Department of Tourism, Finance Department, MSME and Industries Department, a proposal was moved to Finance Department for their views. Finance Department had opined to insert prospective migration in the policy.
4. The cryptic description about the view of Finance Department does not appear adequate for analysis and for that reason, we request Mr. D. Nayak, learned Additional Government Advocate to produce the

records of that consultation that has taken place between various Departments. We think that those papers would give us a scope to look into whether the policy of 2013 had been taken care of during that consultation or not. It is relevant to note that the full content is better reference than the extracts. Even the petitioners may produce the records relating to the policies.

5. Let the matter be listed on 28.11.2022.
6. We make it clear that on that date, there shall be no hearing.
