1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is a bail application U/S.483 of BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Town PS Case No.05 of 2025 corresponding to ST Case No.60/28 of 2025 (GR Case No.13 of 2025) pending in the file of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Sundargarh, being charge-sheeted for commission of offences punishable U/Ss.61(2)/103(2)/3(5) of BNS, on the main allegation of assaulting the deceased Babli Kak by means of lethal weapons, along with co-accused persons resulting in his death.
3. Heard, Mr. Uma Shankar Patel, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. M.K. Mohanty, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor in the present matter and perused the record.
4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of



the offences as alleged against the petitioner vis-à-vis the allegation sought to be brought against him and regard being had to the materials collected in support of the allegation against the petitioner and there being eye witness account to the occurrence and taking into account the opinion of doctor as to cause of death of the deceased in the PM report and keeping in view to totality of the circumstances available on record, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage, when the eye witnesses are yet to be examined.

5. Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stands rejected. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of.
