1. Heard.

2. The petitioner has assailed the order dated 27.11.2019 passed by the learned S.D.J.M., Puri in G.R. Case No.1415 of 2017 arising out of Baliapanda P.S. Case No.62 of 2015, whereby the learned Court below has taken cognizance of the offences under Sections 419/420 of I.P.C. against him.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner by taking me to the allegations in the F.I.R. as well as the charge-sheet try to impress upon this Court that this is a pure and simple civil dispute and the opposite party No.2 has given a criminal colour to arm twist the petitioner.



4. Although I am not inclined to entertain this petition at this stage, but having regard to the nature of allegation and age of the petitioner and opposite party No.2, I feel it appropriate to refer the matter to the mediation for exploring the possibility of settlement. Learned counsels for both the parties have also the similar view.

5. Accordingly, the matter is relegated to the Orissa High Court Mediation Centre for exploring the possibility of settlement. The Coordinator of the Mediation Centre is directed to fix a date and intimate the parties for exploring the possibility of settlement and submit a report before the Court by the next date of hearing. The parties are directed to appear before the Mediation Centre on the date to be fixed by the Coordinator of the Mediation Centre.

6. Awaiting mediation report, list this matter on 13.03.2025.

7. Interim order passed earlier shall continue till the next date.
