1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
 2. By means of this application, the Petitioner seeks to set aside the order dated 12.07.2024 passed by the learned Judge, Family Court-II, Bhubaneswar and further to direct the Opposite Party to pay interim maintenance of Rs.50,000/- till disposal of the CRP No.28 of 2024.
 3. The background facts of the case are that the Petitioner and Opposite Party solemnized their marriage on 03.05.2022 and after their marriage they maintained a happy conjugal life, however, it did not last long and the dissension between the parties arose on the ground that the wife had suppressed the fact of earlier marriage that had dissolved and the Opposite Party had the second marriage with the Petitioner subsequently. According to the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the Petitioner wife is equally qualified and is an earning member and as such it is rightly held



by the learned court that the Petitioner is entitled to the interim maintenance.

4. Learned counsel for the Opposite Party, on the other hand, submits that the Petitioner wife is highly qualified and has substantial income and it is false to say that he has lost his job.

5. Keeping in view the submission made by the learned counsel for the parties since the matter relates to the interim maintenance and on the submission of learned counsel for both the parties it is agreed that the interim maintenance is for sustenance, a sum of Rs.5,000/- is fixed towards interim maintenance to be paid by the Opposite Party husband to the Petitioner wife. At this stage, learned counsel for the Opposite Party husband submits that he is not in a position to clear the arrear dues and as such a consolidated amount of Rs.30,000/- shall be paid towards arrear maintenance besides the current month.

6. In view of the above, the CRLMP stands disposed of.
