- 01.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
2. This ABLAPL has been filed apprehending arrest consequential to an FIR likely to be instituted at the instance of Opposite Party No.2.
3. Issue notice to the Opposite Party No.2 by Speed Post. Requisites shall be filed by 02.12.2025.
- Informant (Opposite Party No.2) be noticed through the I.O.. Extra copy of the brief for the purpose be served on the learned counsel for the State by 02.12.2025 as well.
4. List this matter on 11.12.2025. Learned counsel for the State is called upon to obtain the Case Diary in the meanwhile.



5. As an interim measure, it is directed that the Petitioner shall not be taken into custody in the event any FIR is instituted at the instance of Opposite Party No.2, till the next date.

In the event steps for issuance of notice are not taken, as directed, the interim order shall stand vacated.

6. It is needless to say that the Petitioner shall cooperate with the Investigating Agency.

7. The Superintendent of Police, taking into account the nature of allegation which are levelled against an official working in the Office of the Superintendent of Police, Berhampur, it is directed that in the event any FIR is instituted against the Petitioner in respect of the any other case the same shall be done with specific orders from the Superintendent of Police, Berhampur.

8. Copy of this order be made over to the learned counsel for the State to do the needful.
